## PRELIMINARY ITINERARY

## Day 1 Tuesday, July 3, 2018

Depart on your transatlantic flight to Berlin, Germany with a possible connection in Frankfurt, Germany. Inflight

## Day 2 Wednesday, July 4, 2018

## Arrival | Berlin

Morning arrival in Berlin. Meet your tour managers. Enjoy a guided city-tour including the renovated Reichstag, the Brandenburg Gate, Checkpoint Charlie, the famed Kurfürstendamm and the Jewish Inflight B/D Quarter. Check int to the hotel. Welcome dinner.

## Day 3 Thursday, July 5, 2018

## **Berlin**

Morning rehearsal for MYO. Afternoon visit to the great Pergamon Museum on the Museum Island in the Spree River. Admire the Pergamon Altar and Market Gate of Miletus. Free afternoon for group pursuits such as seeing the iconic bust of Nefertiti on display in the Neues Museum. Perform the first concert of the tour.

## Day 4 Friday, July 6, 2018

## Berlin | Dresden

Dresden was known as the Florence of the Elbe before its tragic destruction in the final months of World War II. A local guide will show you the newly renovated *Church of Our Lady*, the *Semperoper* and the Zwinger. Visit to the Royal Palace and the priceless Green Vault collection of dazzling "objets d'art," brought together by the various sovereigns of Saxony. Possible evening concert. B/D

## Day 5 Saturday, July 7, 2018

## Dresden | Terezin | Prague

After breakfast, depart for Prague. Our first stop is at Terezín, a WW II Nazi Concentration Camp. After our visit, we continue to Prague where you get settled into the hotel. Evening dinner at a traditional Czech restaurant.

## Day 6 Sunday, July 8, 2018

## Prague

Today we explore the Old Town of Prague. A guided walk starts at the Wenceslas Square and continues to the Old Town Square where you see the Tyne Church, Astronomical Clock, Jan Hus Memorial and the famous Charles Bridge. Perform a concert in the St. Nicholas Church or Czech Music Museum. B/D

## Day 7 Monday, July 9, 2018

## Prague

Sightseeing continues today at the Prague Castle area high above the city. See the Gothic St. Vitus Cathedral and the nearby Golden Lanes, formerly filled with shops of gold and silversmiths. In the Old Town, walk through the old Jewish Quarter. Prague was home to composers Bedřich Smetana and Antonín Dvořák and both are buried in the Vysehradsky Hrbitov Cemetery. Enjoy an evening dinner cruise on the (Vltava) Moldau or attend a concert. B/D

#### Day 8 Tuesday, July 10, 2018 Prague | Wachau Valley | Vienna

Depart for Vienna, music capital of Austria. En route we travel to the Wachau Valley of the Danube River, one of the most beautiful sections and famous for its many vineyards. Make a lunch stop at the Dürnstein Castle and then continue to Vienna. Get settled into the hotel and have dinner in the Old Town. B/D

## Depart from New York-JFK Day 9 Wednesday, July 11, 2018

Vienna

Enjoy a guided sightseeing tour where you see the Ringstrasse with the glittering State Opera House, Imperial Palace, State Apartments, National Library and the Hofburg Chapel, where the Vienna Boys' Choir sings. Enjoy free time to explore and shop on the Stephansplatz. Check in to the hotel. Enjoy dinner in the Old Town at the Augustiner Keller Restaurant. Possible concert in St. Stephen's Cathedral of Vienna. B/D

## Day 10 Thursday, July 12, 2018

## Vienna

Tour the Vienna State Opera House. Its conductors represent the elite of the music world--Gustav Mahler, Richard Strauss, Herbert von Karajan and Lorin Maazel. Later visit *Schönbrunn Palace*, the former summer home of the Hapsburg Family that ruled Austria for centuries. Enjoy free time followed by a special Heurigen dinner with music at the Restaurant Mayer. It is on the Pfarrplatz near Grinzing just outside of Vienna. B/D

## Day 11 Friday, July 13, 2018 Vienna | Eisenstadt | Budapest

We leave Austria today for Budapest. Our first stop is in Eisenstadt to visit the Esterházy Estate and the Haydn Hall. Continue to Budapest and check in to the hotel. Tonight we will enjoy dinner at a local Etterem followed by an evening sightseeing cruise on the Danube River. B/D

## **Day 12 Saturday, July 14, 2018**

## Budapest

Guided sightseeing tour of Budapest this morning. Passing by the Parliament, cross the Danube on the Margaret Bridge and drive to the *Royal Castle* on the Buda side, where we see the Fishermen's Bastion and the Matthias Church. Have time in the afternoon for lunch and souvenir shopping. Enjoy dinner and perform the final concert of the tour in the beautiful Esztergom Basilica or St. Stephen's Cathedral. B/D

## Day 13 Sunday, July 15, 2018

## **Budapest**

You have the entire day to enjoy Budapest. Venture out in small groups and explore the city on foot or using public transportation. Visit the Great Market Hall. The unique Széchenyi Thermal Baths are fun if you enjoy swimming and there is excellent souvenir shopping on Andrassy Avenue and on the pedestrian-only Váci Street. Tonight, enjoy a special farewell dinner with Hungarian music on the banks of the Danube at Borkatakomba Etterem. B/D

#### Day 14 Monday, July 16, 2018 Budapest | Return to JFK

Travel to the Budapest Airport where you check in for the return flights to the United States. Make a connection in Frankfurt before flying non-stop to New York-JFK. Clear U.S. Customs and arrive home in the afternoon. B/Inflight
