

## Vincent Fasano



#### **Vincent Fasano**

Hailed as "a true artist who really understands the art of scoring" (Mark Snow), Vincent Fasano is a Film, Game and New Media composer who has a deep love for the orchestra, experimenting with new music and collaborating with others. As a classical and jazz pianist, Vincent specializes in orchestral scores and instrumental writing, as well as MIDI mockups and score notation. As a graduate of the Peabody Conservatory at The Johns Hopkins University, he had the opportunity to study film, game and classical composition with renowned faculty like Thomas Dolby, Christopher Kennedy, Omar Thomas, and Joel Puckett. While there he had the chance to write music for different types of media, including Virtual Reality, Podcasts, Orchestral Ensembles, Jazz and Choral groups among others.

Currently residing in LA, Vincent works as an administrative assistant and orchestrator for the music library company MPATH Tracks and is a composer assistant to Michael Levine. Vincent's work can be heard in orchestrations for the Netflix original series Bridgerton as well as The Big Apple Circus which was staged in New York City. He is also currently a Lead Composer and Audio Director for the game studio Double Coconut, as well as a music copyist and production contractor for Fine Line Music Service. Vincent is also an alumni of MYO, graduating in 2018 and receiving a MYO senior scholarship the same year. He credits his time spent immersed in the Symphony and Principal orchestra as formative to his understanding of orchestral writing and music in general. He is incredibly honored to take part in the 30th anniversary celebration of MYO.

#### Program Notes for Fanfare for Fireworks

The idea for this Fanfare came about when I was given the opportunity to write a piece for the Peabody Conservatory's Music for New Media composition reading. This is my first concert piece for full orchestra and I wanted to make it special and exciting, so I came up with the idea of writing a fanfare that brought to mind the idea of watching a spectacular and colorful firework show.

The opening theme acts as a call to attention, a preamble of sorts before the show begins. We then have a percussion break as a countdown from 10 starts. Finally the show commences. The woodwinds act as the fireworks rising and bursting, the percussion aiding in their colorful release. The strings and brass act as the audience who are excitedly and joyfully watching the fiery and exuberant display. The show goes through exhilaration, and at times apprehension, of the brilliant showcase, finally culminating in the dramatic finale. The main fanfare theme blasts off towards the sky, as the audience waits with bated breath to see the final burst.

Lastly, I want to dedicate the piece to my Dad. This piece was largely inspired by him and his crazy firework obsession. The idea for the countdown and dramatic bursts, including the apprehensive section in the middle, was all brought about by watching him create his own firework shows throughout the years. I like to think this piece is paying homage to him and to my early years in a way. So here's to you Dad, thanks for always inspiring me and pushing me forward. Onward and Upward!

## Phil Preddice



#### **Phil Preddice**

Phil Preddice (Suffolk Principal Orchestra) is a graduate of the Crane School of Music where he studied viola with Lamar Alsop, Theodore Israel, and Maurice Baritaud. His conducting studies were carefully guided by Professor Brock McElheran. Performances under the batons of Eugene Ormandy, Stanley Chappel, Christopher Keene, and Aaron Copland inspired Mr. Preddice to reach for new heights as a conductor. He has been the conductor of the Suffolk Principal Orchestra since its formation in 2008. Mr. Preddice is the founding and Principal Conductor of the Crane Alumni Festival Orchestra. This ensemble, founded in 2014 performs concerts to raise scholarship funds for students wishing to pursue advanced music studies at the Crane School of Music at SUNY Potsdam. Mr. Preddice is a composer, with several works premiered by the MYO Suffolk Principal Orchestra. Mr. Preddice is a past President of the Suffolk County Music Educators' Association. Additionally, he has held executive Board Positions with the Long Island String Festival Association, and the New York State American String Teachers' Association. He is currently retired from a career as Orchestra director in the Commack, Shoreham-Wading River, and Three Village school districts. Mr. Preddice is the recipient of the 2000 Helen Hosmer Excellence in Music Teaching Award, granted by the Alumni Association of the Crane School of Music at SUNY Potsdam.

#### Felicya Schwarzman

Felicya Schwarzman (Suffolk String Orchestra) is the Orchestra and Guitar Director at Half Hollow Hills High School East. Over the course of her time at Half Hollow Hills, she founded the 3rd grade string program, the High School East Guitar Program, and Cello Choir. Felicya holds a Bachelor of Music Education from Ithaca College and a Master of Music Education with an Advanced Certificate in Bilingual/Bicultural Education from Teachers College, Columbia University. In 2021, she received the SCMEA Music Educator Innovator Award, and her Guitar Ensemble was recognized in the Long Island Music Hall of Fame High School Recognition program. This year, her Guitar Ensemble is performing at the All-Eastern Music Conference. Felicya is the President of NY-ASTA Chapter where she helped found the annual NY-ASTA CelloFest. Her experiences as a clinician include the SCMEA All County Festival, NYSSMA Summer & Winter Conferences, and Universidad Sergio Arboleda. In these workshops, she discussed her passion for non-traditional methods of playing the cello and how to develop contemporary ensembles in public schools. She also serves her local community as a SCMEA Festival Chairperson. As a professional cellist and violinist, she performs in the South Shore Symphony Orchestra. In addition, she has adjudicated and coached the NY All State Symphony Orchestra Cello Section. She most recently played violin on the MYO Italy Tour this past summer. Felicya is a proud alumna of the Metropolitan Youth Orchestra of New York. She joined the MYO family as a violinist in 2007 and then as a cellist a year later. She started working behind the scenes as the MYO Summer Intern during college, then as the Cello Coach for the Nassau String and Concert Orchestras and is thrilled to continue working with MYO's talented musicians.

## Scott Zarchy



#### **Scott Zarchy**

Scott Zarchy (Suffolk Symphony Orchestra) is a music educator, cellist, and composer. Mr. Zarchy received undergraduate degrees in Cello Performance and Music Education from the Peabody Conservatory, where he also completed studies in composition. He received a Master of Music degree in Music Education from Boston University and a Master of Arts in Music Composition from Hunter College (CUNY). Mr. Zarchy studied the cello at Peabody with the late Mihaly Virizlay, 40-year Principal Cellist of the Baltimore Symphony, and Alan Stepansky, former Associate Principal of the New York Philharmonic. Mr. Zarchy also performed in master classes with cellists including Alisa Weilerstein, Natasha Brofsky, and Amit Peled. Mr. Zarchy was the founding conductor of the MYO Suffolk Concert Orchestra from its inception in 2009 until 2013, at which time he became the founding conductor of the Suffolk Symphony Orchestra. Mr. Zarchy has been the orchestra teacher, as well as pit orchestra and chamber orchestra director, at Patchogue-Medford High School since 2006, where his ensembles have regularly achieved NYSSMA Level VI Gold and Gold with Distinction ratings. Mr. Zarchy's public school conducting has spanned a wide range of genres, including extensive musical theater work, film music, combined choral/instrumental works and jazz, as well as more traditional classical repertoire. Mr. Zarchy is an active member of the Long Island music education community and, in 2020, served as guest conductor of the Nassau All-County Division III Orchestra. He is also a former executive board member of LISFA.




