Meredith was a winner of the MYO 2022-2023 Concerto and Vocal Competition and the New York Flute Club 2022 Young Musicians Contest. She is a Long Island Scholar-Artist Merit Award recipient and has received many awards for musicianship and dedication to music. Meredith performed with the NYSSMA 2022 All-State Symphonic Band and was recently selected to perform with the NYSSMA 2023 All-State Symphony Orchestra. Meredith is a member of the Herricks High School Honors Wind Ensemble and has performed as Principal Flute with MYO, Long Island Youth Orchestra, Nassau-Suffolk Performing Arts, and Children's Orchestra Society. She has performed in masterclasses with world-renowned flutists and has participated at summer music programs most recently including the Young Artists Orchestra at Boston University Tanglewood Institute, Orford Music Academy, and Oyster Bay Music Festival. Catherine Birke (Nassau Symphony Orchestra) is an energetic and passionate conductor, violinist, and educator. She is the Music Director of the Music Advancement Program (MAP) at The Juilliard School and the Director of Orchestras at Herricks High School. At Herricks, she conducts over 200 students in four thriving orchestras and her ensembles consistently earn the highest rating of "Gold with Distinction" at the NYSSMA Major Evaluation Festival. Under her direction, the Herricks HS Chamber Orchestra won 1st Place in the American String Teachers' Association (ASTA) 2018 National Orchestra Festival. Her small chamber ensembles consistently earn high honors as well, including annual participation in the Lincoln Center Chamber Music Society's (CMS) Young Musicians Program (YMP) competition, where three ensembles coached by Ms. Birke were selected for the regional semi-final and two ensembles were selected as finalists in 2022. For six years, Ms. Birke served as the Director of Strings at the New York State Summer School of the Arts (NYSSSA) School of Orchestral Studies, an intensive residential summer program for advanced high school musicians co-sponsored by the Philadelphia Orchestra. She is an adjunct Music Education faculty member at Hofstra University. A sought-after guest conductor and an accomplished violinist, Birke performs regularly as the Concertmaster of the South Shore Symphony and Long Island Lyric Opera, and has served as both an orchestra chairperson and a Vice-President on the Executive Board of NMEA. Ms. Birke holds a Bachelor of Music degree from Temple University (where she studied with Co-concertmaster of the Philadelphia Orchestra, William DePasquale), a Master of Music degree from the University of the Arts, and an Advanced Certificate in Music Theory from Berklee College of Music.

Peggy Ho (Nassau Concert Orchestra) began her musical training on clarinet, piano, and violin in grade school. She holds a Bachelor of Music in education and clarinet performance from Ithaca College, a Master of Arts in music history from LI University, a Master of Arts in conducting from Hofstra University, and Doctorate in music education from Teachers College, Columbia University. Her clarinet teachers include Naomi Drucker, Richard Faria, and Ayako Oshima Neidich. Having traveled extensively throughout the world, Dr. Ho has performed as principal clarinetist with the North American Elite Youth Orchestra, the Long Island Youth Orchestra, and performed with the Rome Music Festival. She has guest conducted regional and district orchestras throughout New York. Her interest in the expansion of the performance education programs to include portfolio and project based assessment have led her to share her thoughts as presenter at various music conferences, including the Winter NYSSMA Conference, Balanced Curriculum Mind Conference, and NYSBDA Symposium. Dr. Ho is a featured educator in NYSSMA's DVD Music Views and has been published in School Music News. She is currently the Director of Bands at the Wheatley School in East Williston, NY.

Michelina Sobolewski (Nassau String Orchestra) received her Bachelor of Music Education from the Crane School of Music, where she studied Viola with Dr. Peter Bucknell and Dr. Shelly Tramposh. She received her Master's degree from Stony Brook University, and Suzuki certification from the Hartt School of Music under the guidance of Carrie Reuning-Hummel, one of the first Suzuki students in the United States. Mrs. Sobolewski is an active member of the music community, having served as a chairperson for Nassau County Music Educators Association (NMEA), the executive board of the Long Island String Festival (LISFA) and guest conductor for the Suffolk County Music Educators Association (SCMEA). She has performed with the Sound Symphony Orchestra, Crane Alumni Orchestra, and is a pit musician for the Manhasset School District. Mrs. Sobolewski has been a clinician for NYSCAME and Balanced Mind Conferences, presenting workshops on curriculum, mindfulness, and programming. In addition to her passion for music, she is a certified yoga instructor for both children and adults, focusing on how breathing and mindfulness can help to improve performance. Mrs. Sobolewski is currently an elementary orchestra teacher in the Herricks School District. Her orchestras perform regularly at the NYSSMA Major Organization Evaluation Festival, consistently receiving "Gold" and "Gold with Distinction" ratings.

Scott Stickley (Nassau Principal Orchestra) is one of The Metropolitan Youth Orchestra of New York's longest-tenured conductors. Since MYO's inception, Mr. Stickley has seen the organization become one of the largest youth orchestra and choir programs in the country. Highlights of Maestro Stickley's tenure include the Carnegie Hall premiere of Jennifer Higdon's Cold Mountain Suite in May 2023, an audience-acclaimed tour of Italy in July 2022 featuring a performance at the Florence Youth Orchestra Festival; a performance at Jazz at Lincoln Center of the 2019 MYO award winning composition On-Again, Off Again by Juilliard graduate Jack Frerer, 2016 MYO Orchestra performance at the Granada International Festival of Music and Dance; a 2014 Carnegie Hall world premiere of Norwegian composer Ola Gjeilo's choral masterwork To the East and To the West; a dynamic 2007 performance at the New York State School Music Association Conference; a first-time MYO performance of Beethoven's Ninth Symphony at David Geffen Hall in 2006; and a 2004 performance of Pulitzer Prize-winning composer Paul Moravec's MYO commission and world premiere, New York Dances. Soloists featured with MYO under his direction include the New York Philharmonic's clarinetist Stanley Drucker, Metropolitan Opera soprano Danielle de Niese, and international piano soloist Gilles Vonsattel. Scott Stickley teaches instrumental music for the Herricks Schools, has served as interim director for the Adelphi University orchestra, and guest conducted the orchestra at the Crane School of Music at SUNY Potsdam. Hailing from Oregon, he holds degrees from the University of Oregon and the University of Michigan. He studied conducting at the Tanglewood Music Center and attended conducting seminars with Gustav Meier, Michael Tilson Thomas, and Roger Norrington.

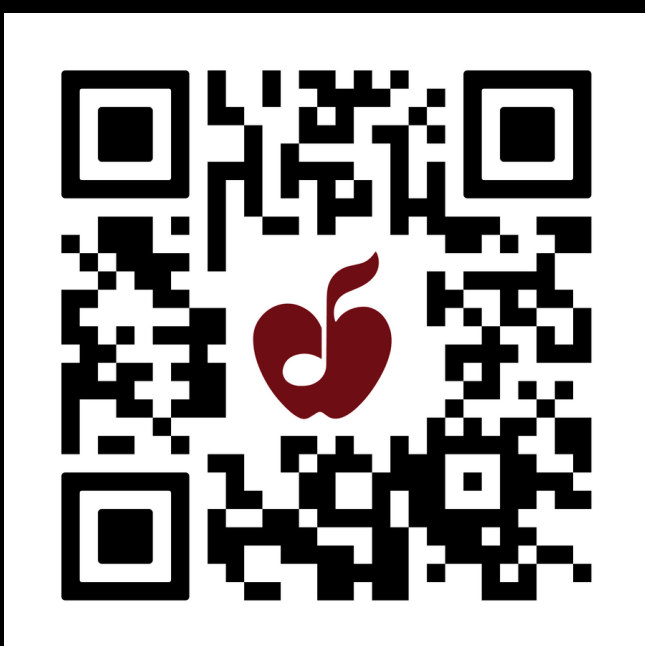
